The United States was the definitive engineering and technology leader of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. However, in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, this leadership position is being challenged by other nations.

As other nations advance, it is becoming ever more important to our national security, geostrategic position, and economic well-being that America continues to advance, innovate, and lead.

The *Endless Frontier Act* is a strategic investment of \$100 billion intended to strengthen engineering and scientific research in key technologies of our future. This legislation also supports commercialization of these key technologies, along with funding for education and training programs in technology areas critical to our national security. This investment will result in new businesses and jobs for our country.
